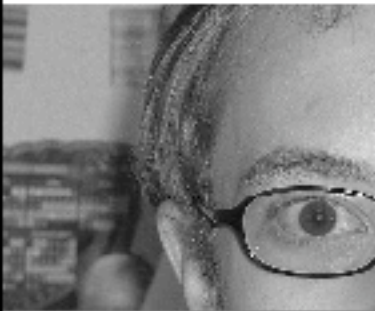


# Editor *biographies*

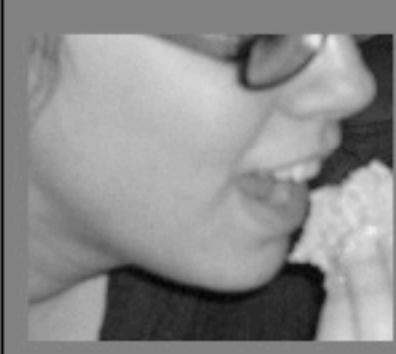

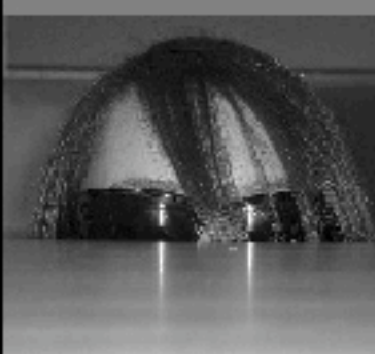
